## Overview:

May 26, 2010: Image Vault announces the release of Version 9.3.5 Record Software for use on all Image Vault Pro Command DVRs with a serial number of IV2007001001 or greater. The 9.3.5 Record & Playback Software can be found on Image Vault's website at:

## New features included in Version 9.3.5 Release:

In response to customer input and in conjunction with Image Vault's goal of continuously improving its software, the following features/options have been included in this release:

- Addition of 2 CIF (704x240) and HVGA (640x240) resolution settings
  - Improved picture quality at lower file sizes
  - Improved "image tearing" for cameras installed in high-motion environments
- Full PTZ control for remote and on-site connections
  - On-screen PTZ control GUI allowing users to move PTZ cameras via Image Vault Software.
  - Includes option to set tours and presets
- Per camera image brightness/contrast adjustments
- Improvements to features within the "Find Button" searches:
  - Added Previous Button to allow for backing up to last item viewed
  - POS Find List – Displays all transactions found during a "Find Button" search in a list by date and time. Users are then able to pick and choose which transaction to view by double clicking on the entry.
  - Save Advanced POS searches
  - Simplified wording for Advanced Find Option
- Picture in Picture during digital zoom
- Multiple Downloads to external USB drive without the need to remove USB drive after each download
- Playback Software improvements:
  - Added "Type Search" Feature to address book
  - Added ability to import and export groups from address book
- Email Alarm Out: Add Store number to Subject Line
- Added ability to download multiple Range Locks to one CD or USB drive
- Added Motion Counter Feature
  - Uses video motion to count each instance of motion on selected camera over a selected period of time.
- Added POS Exception "Rule Cancel" Option
  - Create exception or alert on "Refund" when there is no customer in line.

## Important Notes\*\*

- All 9.3.3 Auto Update Save Configurations ON CD'S/DVD'S ONLY must be updated with 9.3.5 Save Configuration files.
  - Failure to update Save Config. files ON CD'S/DVD'S could result in:
    - Resetting the DVR settings back to factory default.
    - Causing the DVR to "hang" during the Auto Update process.
- Configuration Files which have been SAVED ON A PC VIA IV-PLAY SOFTWARE using 9.3.3 software are safe to use when loading configurations to 9.3.5 DVRs.
  - Please note new features found in 9.3.5 will not be programmed when using a 9.3.3 Save Configuration File.
